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Despite high levels of interest in learning GAC among residents, training programs struggle to incorporate this training due to restraints on time and faculty expertise.

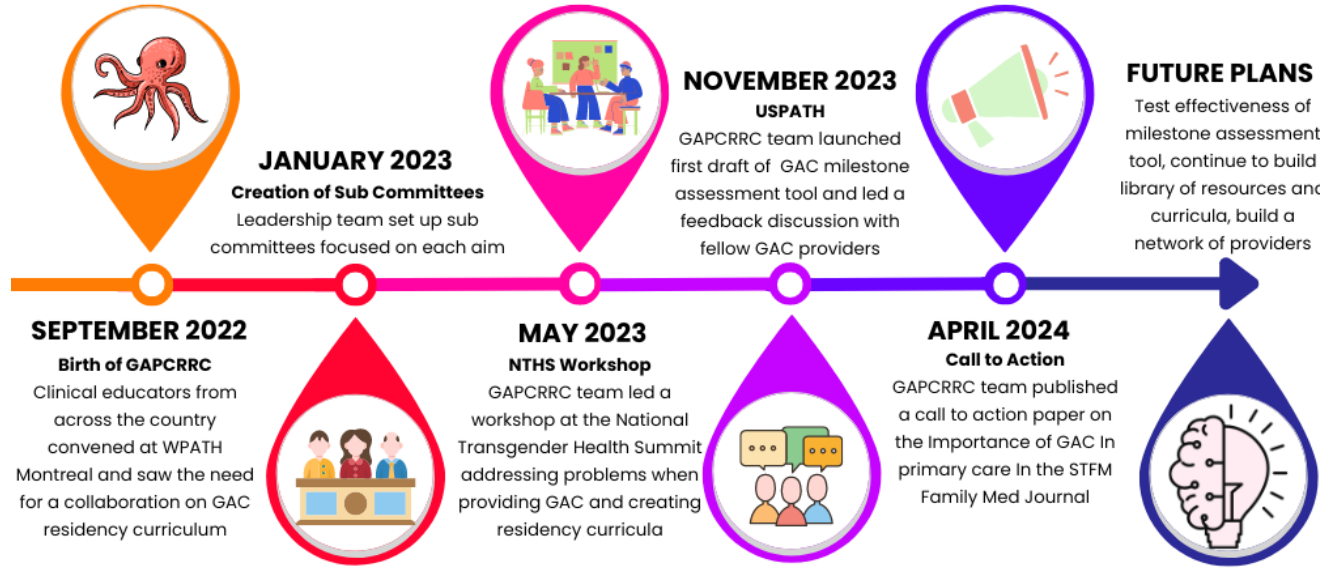
GOAL: To increase the number of physicians trained in Gender-Affirming Care (GAC) by:
